

- 1800** A group of Cataka Indians join the Kiowa and head south. There they meet the Apache and the Kiowa-Apache Indians are formed.
(Conjecture: Turok says this happened "about 200 years ago.")
- 1802** Master Darque is born.
(Valiant Voice #3)(Valiant Reader #1)(Editor's Note: Darque Passages #1 places this event in 1803.)
- 1805** Sandria Darque, the sister of Master Darque, is born.
(Darque Passages #1)(Valiant Voice #4)
- 1810** The Sect captures Armstrong and locks him in a wine cellar in Rome.
(Archer & Armstrong #3)
- 1812** Archduchess Marie Louise, wife of Napoleon I, seduces Armstrong in her bedchambers at Versailles.
(Conjecture: Marie Louise lived in France for 5 years. This was a year she wasn't pregnant.)
(Archer & Armstrong #0)
- S. Maturin, the ship's surgeon on the HMS Surprise, writes a book entitled *Notes on the Cultures of the South Seas*.
(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #14)
- 1814** Ivar, the Timewalker, establishes a safehouse in Woodstock, New York. He acquires the house after providing Francis Scott Key with the lyrics to *The Star Spangled Banner*.
(Timewalker #5)
- 1822** **July 17** – A meteorite hits Acclamation, Oregon.
(PunX #1)
- 1832** Turok, son of Stone, is born.
(Editor's Note: Turok is 10 years older than Andar.)(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #0)
- 1833** **June** – The father of Gary Abrams, a Texas citizen, dies of cholera.
(Eternal Warrior #20)
- 1834** **April** – Gilad fights in a battle during the Texas Revolution. He meets a young boy named Gary Abrams who dies. After the battle Gilad heads north and begins using Abrams as his new last name.
(Eternal Warrior #20)
- 1836** The Geomancer, a Cherokee in Georgia, kills the men who killed his family and destroyed his village.
(Geomancer #6)
- The Battle of the Alamo, a pivotal moment in the Texas Revolution, takes place. Daniel Boone and Sam Houston are killed.
(Eternal Warrior #20)

- 1839** Gilad is present for the beginning of the Opium Wars in China.
(Eternal Warrior #7)
- 1840** Master Darque travels to New Orleans, Louisiana.
(Darque Passages #1)
- 1841** Turok learns how to use a bow and arrow and is inducted into the Rabbit Society.
(Conjecture: Assumes Turok is 9 when this happened.)(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #0)
- 1842** Andar is born.
(Conjecture: Assumes he's 18 when he enters the Lost Land.)(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #0)
- 1843** Armstrong and Master Darque meet.
(Shadowman #17)(Editor's Note: Darque Passages #1 places this event in 1850.)
- 1844** Gilad fights alongside of Ma'ah Ghurdan and helps create the nation of Djurkistan. After the battle Gilad follows the Geomancer's guidance and kills Ghurdan. He tells the people of Djurkistan that one day a messenger will come to their nation named Ma'ah Bishmah.
(Eternal Warrior #47)
- Anjenetta Grampion is born.
(Shadowman #0)(Shadowman #30)
- Gilad fights a Sioux warrior. Gilad's eyes are sewn open and he is blinded by the desert sun.
(Eternal Warrior #23)
- 1848** Turok's tribe travels west to avoid the White traders.
(Conjecture: Sometime before Turok #43.)(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #0)
- Phineas Gage, a railroad worker, has a railroad spike go through his head. The accident affects his frontal lobe and changes his personality.
(Ninjak #00)
- Turok Dinosaur Hunter #43 – "Son of Stone, Part 1"**
Turok travels to a Nez Perce camp to steal horses for tribute to win Ravenwing as his bride.
(Conjecture: Assumes Turok is 16 in this story.)
- Turok Dinosaur Hunter #44 – "Son of Stone, Part 2"**
The Blackfoot attack the Nez Perce and steal the horses that Turok was hoping to take. Turok follows the Blackfoot to take the horses for himself.
- 1849** Turok manages to steal one horse from the Blackfoot. He brings it to Ravenwing's father for tribute. Her father accepts and gives him his daughter's hand in marriage. Ravenwing is killed by Nez Perce warriors who believe that Turok stole the horse from them. Turok kills the Nez Perce warriors and disappears into the prairie.
(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #44)

Sir George Caley invents a glider that is able to fly several yards.

(Vintage Magnus Robot Fighter #4)

1850 After having arrived from the year 3039 B.C., Ivar, now the Timewalker, and a female companion emerge from a time arc. The girl is killed because her body could not handle the abuse of the time arc. Ivar explores the new world he's in and is nearly run over by a locomotive.

(Conjecture: Appears to be a 19th century locomotive.)(Timewalker #0)

1851 Naiche, the Chief of Turok's tribe, travels to the prairie and invites him to return home after several years of self exile.

(Conjecture: It appears significant time has passed.)(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #44)

Master Darque explores the nature of death and reality.

(Conjecture: This happened when he was "approaching fifty.")(Darque Passages #1)

Turok becomes Andar's teacher.

(Conjecture: Sometime before Turok: The Hunted #1.)(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #0)

1852 **Turok: The Hunted #1**

After teaching Andar the proper way to hunt, Turok agrees to help Angus McBride hunt for the white buffalo.

Turok: The Hunted #2

Turok abandons McBride on the plains after leading him to a bear attack. After the bear attack Turok steals McBride's gun. McBride learns to fend for himself without a weapon and learns about the interconnectedness of all life on Earth. Turok leads McBride to the white buffalo.

1854 Commodore Matthew C. Perry forces Japan to open its ports to the west.

(Ninjak #0)(Editor's Note: Iwatsu says the British forced the Japanese ports to be open but Perry was an American.)

Having arrived from the year 1941, Ivar, the Timewalker, ends up in Sarum during the Crimean War.

(Timewalker #1)

Timewalker #2 – "The Enemy is There"

October 23 – Ivar tries to convince Captain Louis Edward Nolan that he will participate in the disastrous Charge of the Light Brigade. Nolan, feeling Ivar is insulting his honor challenges him to a duel.

October 24 – Ivar loses to Nolan in the duel and is left for dead.

October 25 – Ivar is inadvertently responsible for the Charge of the Light Brigade. He realizes that he cannot change history. Ivar catches a time arc and ends up in the year 2033.

- 1859** John Brown, an abolitionist, leads an attack on the armory at Harper's Ferry, West Virginia.
(Editor's Note – The date, the name, and the place can be seen as graffiti in Los Angeles.)(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #12)
- 1860** **Spring** – Turok rescues a family from two Apache warriors. One of the Apache is known as the Snakehandler, and before Turok kills him he promises that he will rise from the grave one day and take his revenge on Turok.
(Turok #16)
- Turok meets Satanta, the Kiowa war chief.
(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #0)
- Turok and Andar enter the Lost Land.
(Editor's Note: Valiant Voice #2 and Valiant Voice #4 place this event in 1854, but we know it was later than that from dialogue in Turok #16.)(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #0)
- 1861** Wild Bill Hickok leaves Nebraska after living there for three years. The prairie never forgets him.
(Shadowman #15)
- Ivar, the Timewalker, duels with Hickok. Hickok shoots Ivar's tachyon compass, the device that lets Ivar navigate through time.
(Timewalker #3)(Conjecture: Assumes this event happens at the height of Hickok's dueling.)
- 1862** Buck McHenry is born.
(Solar, Man of the Atom #10)
- 1865** The American Civil War ends. Jeremiah Thornton, a Union soldier from Rhode Island, settles in New Orleans.
(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #14)
- 1866** Gilad has his first encounter with the crime families of Sicily, also known as the Mafiosa.
(Bloodshot #0)
- 1867** An artist paints the famous Voodoo Queen Marie Leveau. Master Darque can be seen in the painting's background.
(Shadowman #11)
- 1868** Wilson Haverford Duerst is born.
(Archer & Armstrong #15)
- Gilad Abrams is ambushed in Texas with a group of rangers hunting criminals. The Geomancer, Scout, finds Abrams and the two of them begin fighting crime together.
(Conjecture: Caption says the "late 1860's.")(Eternal Warrior #15)
- 1870** Medoc, a French wine, bottled this year is a particular favorite of Armstrong's in 1901.
(Shadowman Yearbook #1)

- 1871** Frederic Leighton gives Armstrong the original painting of Flaming June.
(Archer & Armstrong #5)
- 1872** Gilad spends some time in the London Sewers.
(Eternal Warrior #24)
- The Mary Celeste, a British merchant ship, is discovered with her entire crew missing.
(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #16)
- 1876** Gilad and Aram fight at General Custer's last stand.
(Archer & Armstrong/Eternal Warrior #8)
- 1877** Crazy Horse, the Lakota warrior, dies. The prairie never forgets him.
(Shadowman #15)
- 1878** A half-case of Lafite de Luze is made. This wine has a superior oak to ones that come out next year.
(Archer & Armstrong #5)
- 1879** Medoc, a French wine, from this year is a particular favorite of Armstrong's in 1901.
(Shadowman Yearbook #1)
- 1881** Ivar explores Europe. In Africa the Boer War is taking place.
(Archer & Armstrong #10)
- 1885** Jeremiah Thornton returns to Rhode Island from New Orleans where he made a fortune. He begins construction on a new house.
(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #14)
- 1887** Ivar the Timewalker, while being hung by Judge Roy Bean, is sucked into a time arc and brought to the year 1921.
(Timewalker #12)
- 1888** Elwood Quigley is killed by his son, Anton Quigley.
(Shadowman #32)(Shadowman #33)
- A bottle of Rothschild Bordeaux is made. This is a particular favorite of Armstrong's in 1901.
(Shadowman Yearbook #1)
- Jeremiah Thornton completes construction of a house in Rhode Island called Thornton Manor. Locals believe the house is haunted.
(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #14)
- November** – Gilad catches Jack the Ripper committing a murder. Gilad tells Jack that he's Jack's father. The two fight and Jack disappears.
(Eternal Warrior #33)

November - Gilad and Buck McHenry, the new Geomancer, discuss Jack the Ripper. Gilad continues his search for Jack. He encounters a woman named Diane Glastoner who is his daughter. She uses her enhanced strength to kill and has been nicknamed Jack the Ripper.

(Eternal Warrior #34)

November - Gilad kills his daughter Diane. The mystery of who Jack the Ripper was is never revealed.

(Eternal Warrior #35)(Editor's Note: In Eternal Warrior #24 Gilad refers to his fight with Jack the Ripper having taken place "twenty years ago" even though it was 24 years ago.)

1889 Buck McHenry saves Gilad's life in Arizona.

(Eternal Warrior #6)(Eternal Warrior #7)

1890 A very dry section of the Gobi Desert gets rain. It won't rain there again for a century.

(Solar, Man of the Atom #3)

Gilad kills Colonel Marlon, a man who had been organizing poachers to kill elephants for their tusks.

(Eternal Warrior #14)

1893 A voodoo coven forms to oppose the plans of Master Darque.

(Shadowman #18)

Politicians and law enforcement pledge to clean Times Square in New York City.

(Timewalker #3)

1894 Master Darque and his sister Sandria are photographed at a garden party.

(Shadowman #11)

The Tower Bridge in London opens.

(Secret Weapons #15)

Mama Maxine is born.

(Shadowman #33)

1895 Master Darque learns the power of resurrection from Anton Quigley. Nettie turns Maxim St. James into a Shadowman. Sandria Darque is killed by Quigley and is resurrected by Master Darque. St. James kills Quigley and confronts Darque. Darque has also mastered the ability to create fire and sets fire to the building they are all in. St. James and Nettie are trapped in the burning building.

(Shadowman #0)

Having arrived from the year 2937, Shadowman, who is traveling through time from the year 1993 for Master Darque, ends up in New Orleans. There he finds Nettie in a burning building with Maxim St. James.

(Shadowman #21)

Shadowman attacks Maxim St. James. Before the fight is over Shadowman is sucked back into another time portal back to the year 2937.

(Shadowman #22)

Shadowman returns from the year 1993 to the exact moment he had left before. He learns that Maxim St. James is also a Shadowman. Shadowman rescues Nettie from the burning building and they travel to the bayou. Doctor Mirage travels through a time portal to bring Shadowman back to 1993.

(Shadowman #23)

1897 Armstrong participates in a voodoo ritual in the bayou.

(Shadowman #18)

1899 Buck McHenry survives a large fall into the Colorado River.

(Conjecture: Gilad says it happened "a few years back.") (Eternal Warrior #24)

1900 John Douglas, the Marquess of Queensberry dies.

(Shadowman Yearbook #1)

Armstrong introduces Charles Rolls to Henry Royce.

(Archer & Armstrong #4)

Cedric Baseheart, a man with no past and no money, arrives in London. Within two weeks he earns enough gambling to open his own club. He calls it the Hellfire Club.

(Shadowman Yearbook #1)

June 21 – The Hellfire Club attempts to tap into the necromantic energy pool but fails because their sacrifice is not a virgin.

(Shadowman Yearbook #1)

1901 **Shadowman Yearbook #1**

June 19 – Maxim St. James travels aboard the steamship Intrepid to Southampton, England. He foils a kidnapping attempt of Penelope Mather while aboard.

June 21 – Maxim St. James arrives in England and meets up with Armstrong. The two go gambling at the Hellfire club and Max loses all his money. In order to cover his bets Max enters a boxing match.

June 22 – Maxim wins his boxing match and rescues Penelope again from the Hellfire Club.

1903 Orville and Wilbur Wright invent and fly the first airplane.

(Vintage Magnus Robot Fighter #4)

Ivar, the Timewalker, having travelled from the year 1998, meets the two brothers. The brothers teach Ivar how to fly a plane. Ivar catches a time arc to the year 1918.

(Timewalker #3)

1908 Andar returns from the Lost Land after the events in Unity.
(Conjecture: Andar says "80-90 years ago.")(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #4)

1909 Armstrong visits New Orleans.
(Shadowman #17)

1910 **Summer** - Houdini shows Armstrong his tricks.
(Archer & Armstrong #3)

Having travelled from the year 1998, Ivar the Timewalker ends up in Paris, France.
(Timewalker #9)

Mac, a friend of Ivar's, arrives in Paris, France through a time arc from 1998. He searches for Ivar but is unable to find him.
(Timewalker #9)

1911 Ivar the Timewalker joins Roald Amundsen's expedition to the South Pole. Ivar catches a time arc at the South Pole to 1998. Roald and his team, while searching for Ivar discover the South Pole.
(Timewalker #9)

Madame Rowena is born.
(Harbinger Hardcover – The Origin of Harada)

1912 Buck McHenry, the Geomancer, leaves New York, never to be seen by his family again.
(Solar, Man of the Atom #10)(Solar, Man of the Atom #14)

Eternal Warrior #24 – "A Bloody Day in London Town"

Buck McHenry travels to London to aide Gilad in his fight against the latest incarnation of the Immortal Enemy. Gilad kills the Immortal Enemy.

(Editor's Note: In Eternal Warrior #4, Gilad says he killed the Immortal Enemy in Germany "before the first World War." He must be confused about the location.)

George Edward Challenger discovers and explores the Lost Land. He collects fossils and notes before returning to South America. His entry way into the Lost Land disappears.
(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #7)

Maxim St. James and Sandria Darque see each for the last time in 83 years.
(Shadowman #42)

1914 Events in Groznia trigger World War I.
(Eternal Warrior #41)

Gilad aids T.E. Lawrence in his attack on Aqaba. During the battle Gilad retrieves the Book of Geomancers, which had been stolen.
(Eternal Warrior #10)

- 1915** Mac builds a tachyon compass in Manet's barn. He uses the compass to send himself to 1973.
(Timewalker #9)
- Armstrong has an encounter with Mae West and three contortionist milk maids.
(Conjecture: Date placed during Mae West's Vaudeville days.)(Archer & Armstrong #0)
- Under the instruction of Buck McHenry, the Geomancer, Gilad leads the Australians to their deaths at the Gallipoli Campaign in Turkey.
(Eternal Warrior Yearbook #1)
- 1916** Armstrong loses both of his legs after they are blown off by a bomb.
(Shadowman #5)(Secrets of the Valiant Universe #1 – Eternal Warrior)
- 1917** Ivar, the Timewalker, having travelled from the year 1903, ends up participating in World War I as a fighter pilot.
(Timewalker #3)
- 1918** Armstrong and Nettie see each other.
(Shadowman #17)
- The US Government starts forcing Native American children to attend schools.
(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #4)
- After having been a World War I fighter pilot for eighteen months, Ivar destroys the Blue Max's plane just before jumping into a time arc that brings him back to 1998.
(Timewalker #3)
- The U.S.S. Cyclops, a US naval vessel, is lost with all hands.
(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #16)
- 1920** Jesse Durant, the son of Gilad Abrams, kills his mother.
(Eternal Warrior #35)
- 1921** **June 5** – In Tulsa, Oklahoma a black man is accused of assaulting a white woman. Racial tensions run high between the black and white communities.
(Timewalker #12)

Timewalker #12 – “Ashes of the Past, Part 1”

June 6 - Having travelled from the year 1887, Ivar the Timewalker arrives in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He meets A.C. Jackson, a black doctor. Members of Tulsa's white community attack Ivar after seeing him in public with Jackson.

Timewalker #13 – “Ashes of the Past, Part 2 – White Fire, Black Heat”

June 6 – Ivar the Timewalker gets caught in the middle of a race riot and is pulled into a time arc before he is able to make sure A.C. Jackson gets to safety. After Ivar leaves Jackson and a couple dozen others are killed and the black section of Tulsa is leveled.

1922 **January 10** – Someone with the last name Adams is born.
(Harbinger #7)

Armstrong’s legs fully grow back.
(Shadowman #5)(Secrets of the Valiant Universe #1 – Eternal Warrior)

1923 **Timewalker #5 – “Ivar and the Ten Commandments”**
Having arrived from the year 1998, Ivar the Timewalker, becomes an extra in Cecile B. DeMille’s *The Ten Commandments*. Ivar helps Cecile scare off the mob, who wants a cut of Hollywood’s fortune. He catches a time arc to the year 2062.

1925 Steiner, a man who will one day work on the creation of the hydrogen bomb, is born.
(Eternal Warrior #21)

A calendar is published for residents of Valiant, Oklahoma. For the month of April downtown Valiant is pictured.
(The Outcast #1)

1926 Jeremiah Thornton, the owner of Thornton Manor mysteriously disappears. Master Darque is believed to be responsible for Thornton’s disappearance.
(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #14)(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #15)

1928 Armstrong learns to dance the Charleston.
(Shadowman #5)

Bentley manufactures a 4.5 litre Le Man Tourer.
(Ninjak #13)

1932 An actor commits suicide by jumping off the roof of the Roosevelt Hotel in Hollywood, California.
(The Visitor #1)

1933 Madame Rowena’s harbinger abilities manifest. Harbingers exhibit special abilities.
(Conjecture: She said she was “twenty-some.”)(Harbinger Hardcover – The Origin of Harada)

1934 Ivar, the Timewalker, informs his brother Gilad that he’s going to need his help breaking out of a Nazi prison in 1941. He also tells Gilad to bring rope.
(Timewalker #1)

1936 The Sarn and Virlyat peoples are merged into one country, Groznia, by the USSR.
(Conjecture: Sometime during the USSR’s existence.)(Eternal Warrior #41)

- 1938** Armstrong watches Charlie “The Bird” Parker play saxophone at the Gato Noir Club in Le Harve, France.
(Archer & Armstrong #9)
- Mae Fong is born in Peking, China.
(Conjecture: Assumes she was 18 when she had Hwen.)
- 1939** The grandfather of Jessica Cranston, a Jewish shopkeeper, makes a crown which is stolen by Nazis when they are forced to leave their homes and put into concentration camps.
(Eternal Warrior #11)
- June** - At the request of Buck McHenry, the Geomancer, Gilad begins working in the German Luftwaffe. Buck tells him to protect Dieter Von Buskirk.
(Conjecture: Gilad watches Dieter for “nearly a year.”)(Eternal Warrior Special #1)
- Ivar the Timewalker learns about the dance called The Big Apple.
(Timewalker #9)
- 1940** **Eternal Warrior Special #1 – “Wings of Justice”**
May – Serving under Dieter Von Buskirk’s command on a German bomber aircraft, Gilad disobeys orders. He parachutes out of the aircraft with Von Buskirk, saving his life by preventing him from carrying out a suicide mission.
- May** - Gilad meets Neville Alcott at Dunkirk, France during World War II. Gilad advances on Heinz Guderian’s forces and is shot. Neville, unaware of Gilad’s healing ability, runs out to rescue him. He is shot multiple times and loses the use of his legs. The British forces at Dunkirk are able to retreat.
(Eternal Warrior #1)(Eternal Warrior #11)
- Neville Alcott spends the next year in a hospital undergoing rehabilitation. He meets Jessica, the woman he will later marry.
(Bloodshot #29)
- 1941** **January 10** – The Japanese attack Shanghai, China. William Michael Pendragon, a young western boy witnesses the death of his mother by a Japanese soldier.
(Ninjak #22)
- Private Pimpole, a British soldier, enters World War II.
(Archer & Armstrong #10)
- Timewalker #1 – “Ivar the Traveller”**
Having arrived from the year 60, Ivar, the Timewalker, breaks Dr. Weisenfeld, a Jewish scientist out of a Nazi prison with the aid of his brother Gilad. Ivar catches a time arc and travels to the year 1854.
- Anjenetta Grampion, also known as Nettie, meets Calvin, a man who can control time.
(Shadowman #23)

- 1942** Mel Hathaway is sent to Europe to fight in World War II.
(Harbinger #21)
- Augustus Silkowski is born in Chicago.
(Ninjak #1)
- William Haverford Duerst joins the Sect. He also begins collecting paintings by Picasso for his art collection.
(Archer & Armstrong #17)(Archer & Armstrong #18)
- Neville Alcott is recruited by British Intelligence.
(Conjecture: Takes place after leaving the hospital after Dunkirk.)(Bloodshot #29)
- Sir Richard Burton and Armstrong travel across Afghanistan on camelback.
(Conjecture: Date is historical.)(Archer & Armstrong #25)
- 1943** Gilad flies a Lockheed Lightning in World War II.
(Conjecture: Sometime during "double-ya double-ya two.")(Archer & Armstrong #7)
- Armstrong and Errol Flynn attend a party at San Sebastian, Spain. Armstrong meets Wilson Haverford Duerst at the party and discusses his art collection with him. Duerst decides to steal Armstrong's art with the hopes that it would be blamed on the Nazis. The Nazi Von Valkenburd sends men to kill Armstrong. Errol Flynn helps Armstrong fight them off.
(Archer & Armstrong #13)(Archer & Armstrong #15)
- Ivar, the Timewalker, studies swordsmanship under Errol Flynn.
(Conjecture: At some point during Flynn's life. Event placed to coincide with Armstrong's adventures with Flynn.)(Timewalker #1)
- Gilad rescues two brothers from the Nazis while in Poland.
(Eternal Warrior #16)(Magnus Robot Fighter #29)
- 1944** The USS Intrepid is involved in many campaigns during World War II in the Pacific Ocean.
(Ninjak #5)
- Mel Hathaway returns from fighting in World War II. When he returns home he finds that Armstrong is dating his fiancée. Mel and some friends run Armstrong out of town.
(Conjecture: Average tour of duty in WWII was 21 months.)(Harbinger #22)
- Maxim St. James goes into a coma and is placed in the Louisiana State Hospital. He is known simply as patient 937.
(Shadowman #29)
- Gilad helps a German named Angstrom destroy a Nazi V-2 rocket factory.
(Eternal Warrior #36)

1945

Captain John King begins work on a Ministry of Defense project in Canterbury, England called "Hope and Glory." The purpose of the project is to create a contingency plan if the Nazi's are successful with their biological weapons program called Schwarz Tod.

(Ninjak #11)

Gilad travels to the stronghold of Ilsa Krofft, a Nazi hiding in northern Bavaria, to rescue Buck McHenry.

(Conjecture: "At the end of World War II.)(Eternal Warrior #43)

Gilad and McHenry escape from Northern Bavaria. Krofft is killed.

(Eternal Warrior #44)

April 7 – Captain John King stops the Nazi biological weapons program called Schwarz Tod in Norway. Sergeant Pinter assists King in the operation. After the missions success project "Hope and Glory" is shut down.

(Ninjak #12)(Bloodshot #42)

Private Pimpole, a British soldier, is preparing to be demobilized when he becomes displaced in time and ends up in the year 1992.

(Archer & Armstrong #10)(Editor's Note: Pimpole is a WWII soldier because he refers to the Germans as Jerrys. Demobilization took place in 1945.)

July 16 – The US government tests a nuclear weapon at White Sands, New Mexico. Many of the men who work on the project eventually die of cancer.

(Solar, Man of the Atom #30)

August 6 – The US drops an atomic bomb on the city of Hiroshima, Japan. Yusaku Okubo, a future Japanese Senator, survives the bombing.

(Ninjak #3)

August 9 – Having arrived from the year 1895, Shadowman, who is travelling through time for Master Darque, arrives in Nagasaki, Japan on the day the US dropped an atomic bomb on the city. Shadowman escapes through a time portal just before the bomb lands and travels to the year 1949.

(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #5)

World War II Ends and Adolf Hitler dies.

(Vintage Magnus Robot Fighter #1)

A group of Nazi Valkyries smuggle the corpse of Hitler out of Berlin and leave a double in its place. The Valkyries enter the Lost Land.

(Turok Dinosaur Hunter #38)

Five torpedo bombers from the US, known as Flight 19, disappear with all hands.

(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #16)

Noriko Harada is born.

(Harbinger Hardcover – The Origin of Harada)

- 1947** Nettie stops using voodoo to maintain her youth.
(Shadowman #17)
- 1948** Harley Davidson makes their last line of Knuckleheads. In 44 years Aric Dacia will own one.
(X-O Manowar #24)
- 1949** Having arrived from the year 1945, Shadowman, who is travelling through time for Master Darque, arrives in war torn Peking, China. Shadowman rescues Mae Fong from tank. Shadowman goes through another time portal to the year 1993.
(The Second Life of Doctor Mirage #5)(Secrets of the Valiant Universe #1 – The Second Life of Doctor Mirage)
- 1950** Phil Seleski is born.
(Conjecture: This assumes that he was 15 when Doctor Solar #15 came out, which he was remembered to have read at high school age.)
- Augustus Silkowski's father Charlie beats him. While chasing Augustus he slips and crashes through a window. He's bitten by a Black Widow spider and dies.
